

Comparison of AAP SOEM Survey Listserv Participants to the General PEM Workforce

The following table reflects the composition of the AAP Section on Emergency Medicine (SOEM) Survey Listserv, compiled in early 2016. Among the approximately 1200 SOEM members 614 responded, with 479 agreeing to fully participate in future AAP SOEM surveys. These 479 members represent the distribution list for all surveys approved by the AAP SOEM Survey Subcommittee (column in yellow). On the far right column (grey) are demographics of the Pediatric Emergency Medicine (PEM) Workforce survey, published by Gorelick et al (*Acad Emerg Med*, 2016 Jan;23(1):48-54); the demographics of the survey participants closely resemble those of the PEM workforce in many respects.

The intent of this document is to demonstrate that the respondents of the AAP SOEM Survey Listserv are fairly representative of PEM providers currently in practice, and can be used a reference for AAP SOEM approved surveys.
